Template integration

Simple CMS relies on a small set of PHP tags for integration. To use any of these tags, all you need to do is include them on your custom template located at:

templates/default/index.php

Simple CMS PHP Tags

Required Tags

Tag	Description	CSS Styling notes
<code><?=\$main_menu; ?></code>	Site navigation menu	styled by nav CSS class
<code><?=\$page_content; ?></code>	Page content	styled by content-full CSS class

Optional Tags

Tag	Description	CSS Styling notes
<code><?=\$sub_menu;?></code>	Navigation sub menu	styled by sidebar CSS class
<code><?=\$keywords;?></code>	SEO keywords. Used on meta tag eg: <code><meta name="Keywords" content="<?=\$keywords;?>" /></code>	
<code><?=\$page_title; ?></code>	Page title. Used between <code><title>TAG</title></code>	styled by content-full CSS class
